Learning to play scales when you're just starting out is a great way to get your left and right hands synchronized. It's also a great way to start exploring the melodic aspect of music. When you're learning new songs try and see if you can learn to play the melodies as well. This will help you remember the song so much better and is a great way to play the intro if you're playing with another guitarist. He plays the chords and you play the melody. Don't get too carried away though and remember to work on your chords and rhythm playing.
